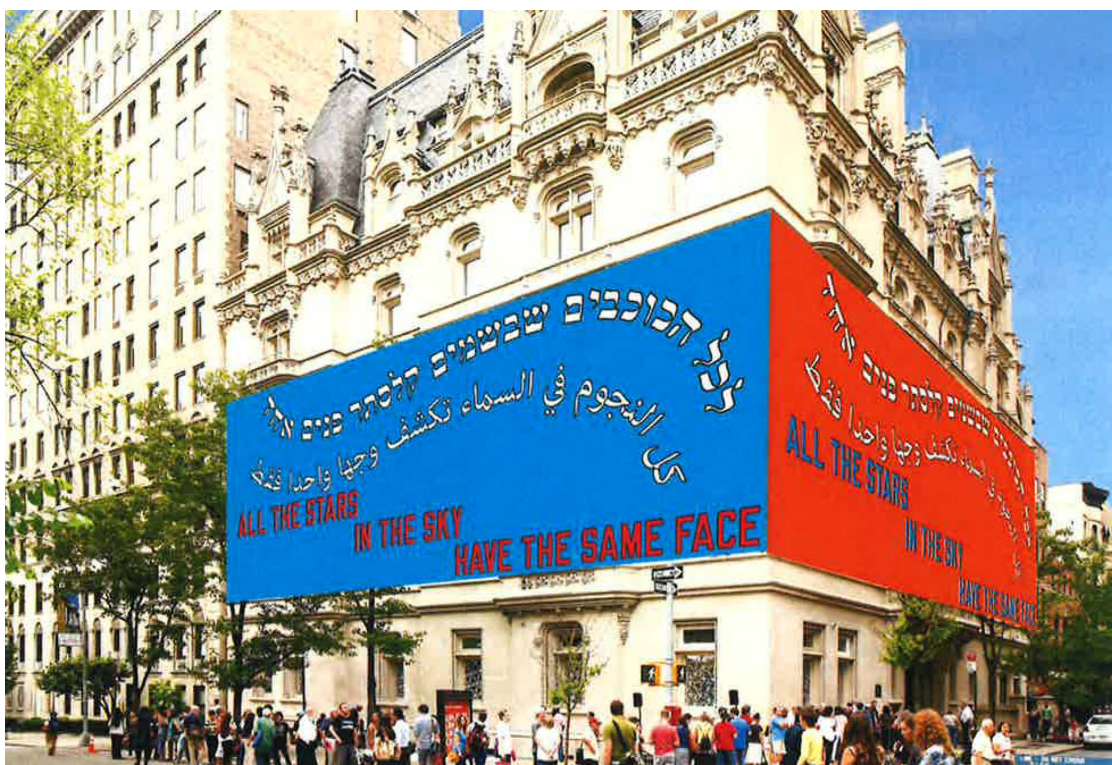


CARNEGIE HILL neighbors

- Installation will require **158 half inch holes drilled directly into the limestone** of the landmark Warburg Mansion equal to 6 ½ feet of open holes exposing this historic façade to the assault of the elements
